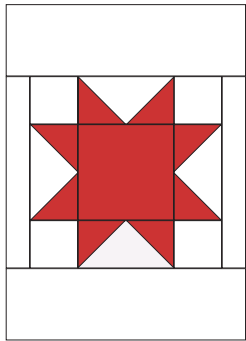


FILLER BLOCK 1:

**CHRISTMAS STAR**

FINISH SIZE: 5" x 7"



CUT:

**A** - (1) 2½" x 2½"

**B** - (4) 1½" x 1½"

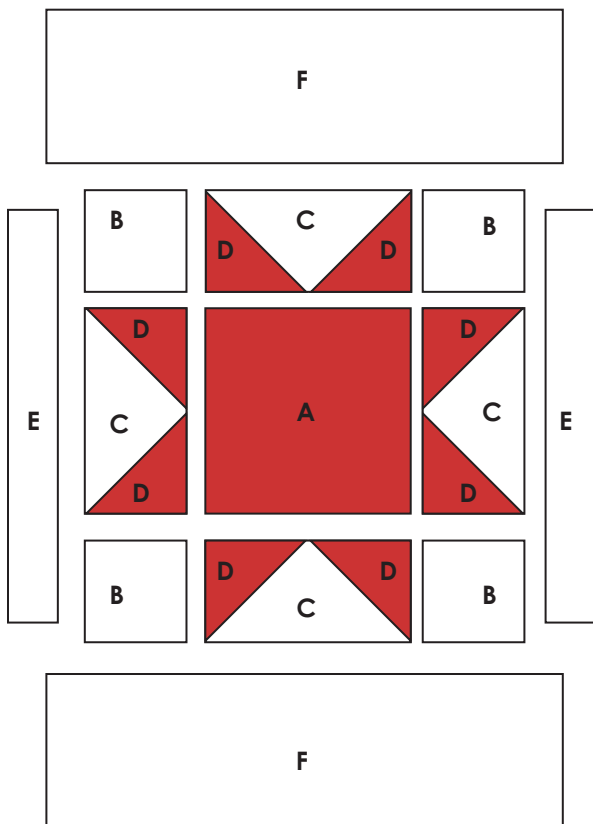
**C** - (1) 3¼" x 3¼"

**D** - (4) 1⅞" x 1⅞"

**E** - (2) 4½" x 1"

**F** - (2) 5½" x 2"

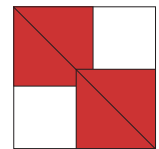
*TIP: For maximum accuracy, cut border pieces slightly larger and then trim block down to 5½"x7½". Cut (E) 4½"x1½" and (F) 6"x2½".*



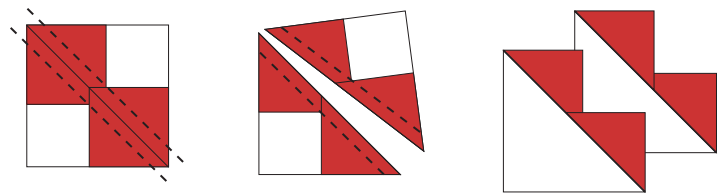
INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Use Fabrics C & D to make 4-at-a-time Flying Geese blocks. On the Wrong Side of the Fabric D squares, use a fabric or other marking tool to draw a diagonal line across from corner to corner.

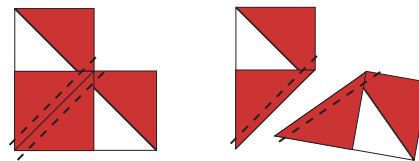
Place (2) Fabric D squares Right Sides Together as shown on top of the Fabric C square, so that the marked lines form a diagonal across Fabric C. Pin to secure.



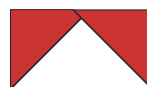
Stitch a scant ¼" along each side of the marked line. Cut along marked line so that each piece has a scant ¼" seam allowance. Press open.



Layer a remaining Fabric D square on each of the pressed units, as shown, so that the marked line runs down the middle. Pin to secure, and stitch a scant ¼" along each side of marked line again.



Cut along marked line, and press seams open. Trim flying geese to 1½" x 2½" if needed.



Make 4.  
Trim to 1½"x2½"

2. Assemble block as shown, pressing seams open. Block will measure 5½" x 7½".
