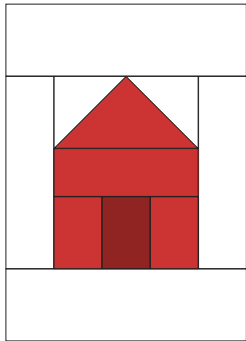


FILLER BLOCK 3:
FAMILY HOME

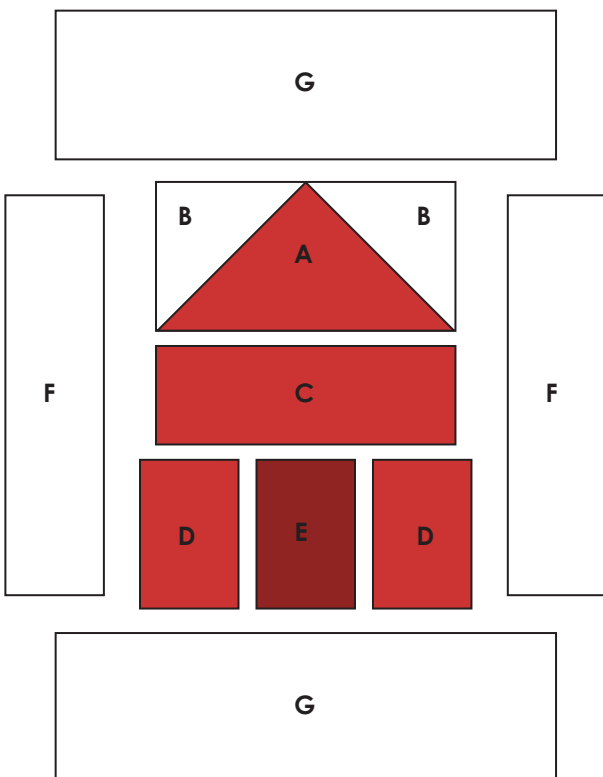
FINISH SIZE: 5" x 7"



CUT:

- A - (1) 2" x 3½"
- B - (2) 2" x 2"
- C - (1) 1½" x 3½"
- D - (2) 1½" x 2"
- E - (1) 1½" x 2"
- F - (2) 4½" x 1½"
- G - (2) 5½" x 2"

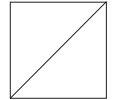
TIP: For maximum accuracy, cut border pieces slightly larger and then trim block down to 5½"x7½". Cut (F) 4½"x2" and (G) 6"x2½".



INSTRUCTIONS:

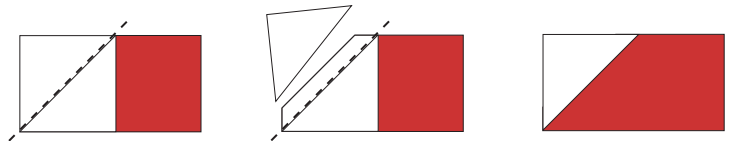
1. Use the sew & flip method to make the roof using Fabrics A & B.

On the Wrong Side of the Fabric B squares, use a fabric pencil or other marking tool to draw a diagonal line across from corner to corner.

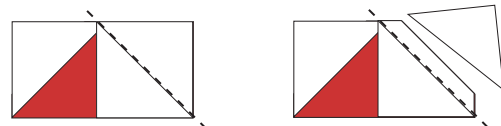


Line up (1) Fabric B square in the corner of Fabric A, Right Sides Together. Pin to secure.

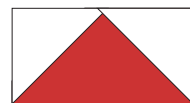
Stitch along the marked line. Trim off excess corner, leaving a scant ¼" seam allowance. Press seam open.



Repeat on opposite corner using other Fabric B square, making sure the marked seam line forms a roof point with the first seam.



Trim to 2"x3½" if needed.



Make 1.
Trim to 2"x3½"

2. Make the door unit. Attach Fabric D pieces to either side of Fabric E. Press seams open.

3. Finish assembling block as shown, pressing seams open. Block will measure 5½" x 7½".
