



Cutting

A (4) 5" squares

B (4) 5" squares

Block is 6.5"

Assembly

1. Place an A square right side together with a B square. Mark a diagonal line on the back and then sew a scant 1/4" away from that line on both sides. Cut along the line. Press towards the darker fabric.
2. Place the two HST (half square triangles you have just made) right side together with the alternate colours together. Pin to ensure the centres are nested well. Mark another diagonal line and sew a scant 1/4" seam either side of that line. Cut along the line. Press open.
3. Repeat to make four hourglass blocks. Trim each block to 3.5" square.
4. Place the blocks together as per the diagram and sew them together in rows and then the two rows together. Press open.
5. Trim to 6.5" square.
